

Trail Etiquette Guidelines

- climb on ruins.
- Use caution around rocky areas and cliffs.
- properly dispose of waste left by pets. Use a secured plastic bag and place in solid waste container.
- Destruction or removal of plants, animals, historical, prehistoric or geological sites and

Distance: 1/5 mile

What to see: Dense underbrush gives way to Cedar one-room schoolhouse.

Ridge Run 🐧 👓

Time to travel: 15-20 minutes

Distance: 7/10 mile

What to see: Sweeping view of the hill country to the East and North, with forest and open field nearby on the South

Sycamore Hollow 🐧 👓

Time to travel: 35-45 minutes

Distance: 3/4 mile

What to see: Dense forest trail paralleling a creek with several water falls, fed by three large springs. Excellent wildlife viewing.

Twisted Creek 🐧 •

Time to travel: 15-20 minutes

Distance: 1/2 mile What to see: Trail follows a stream through quiet Cedar stands and offers beautiful views of the surrounding hills.

Miner Valley Trail 🕺 •••• Time to travel: 20-30 minutes

Distance traveled: 2/5 mile

What to see: A challenging route cut into the woods between the Silver Moon Mine and the King Solomon Mine Trail. Not so much a short cut as a great adventure through the hills, creeks and valleys of the area. See wildlife and all that nature has to offer on this scenic route.

Distance traveled: 1/2 mile

What to see: Trail leading directly to the



Melva Trail 🏌 🐠 🏮 Time to travel: 3 hours

Distance: 4 miles

What to see: Ruins of the old Melva township, circa 1920. Fairly open Cedar glades, trail crosses two streams, very frequent scenic view of the hills to the North and West.

Creekside Trail 💃 🐠 🍨 Time to travel: 30 minutes Distance: 1 mile

What to see: Trail runs the length of Coal Pit Hollow, with excellent opportunities to view wildlife as it leads through timber and follows alongside a creek. A nice rest area with picnic tables along a stream rests at the halfway point along this trail.

Distance: 1/2 mile

What to see: Main trail route passes through dense Cedar will indicate the more advanced trails that lead directly to the King Solomon Mine site, complete with massive open mineshafts, structural ruins and two caves. One supplying water to the mining operation, while the other having possibly tie-ins with the outlaw Alf Bolin.



Murder Rock Rd 🐧 🐠 🌘 Time to travel: 1 hour

Distance: 2.5 miles

What to see: Trail leads to Murder Rock, which was used by Alfred Bolin as an ambush site during the Civil War, Trail also offers commanding views of the surrounding Ozarks.
